How To Apply?

We currently accept international students. Space is limited and we encourage students to apply as soon as possible.

International Students Applications are accepted on a rolling basis for each academic year. Please submit your application and transcripts as soon as possible.

To apply successfully, each applicant must do the following:

- Submit the application for international students;
- Submit the most recent Transcripts in English;
- Submit an self-introduction in English with family pictures (Minimum of 250 words, maximum of 300 words);
- Submit an official copy of your TOEFL score. TOEFL Jr., iTEP, SLATE and ISEE tests are acceptable as well.
- Submit a copy of your Passport;
- Submit two (2) Letters of Recommendation: one from a teacher of your choice and the other from your English teacher;
- Have a Zoom/Google meet Interview with the Director of International Studies.
